In September of 2019 Ganapath with his partivaar moved out to the Baala salyam (baby temple). Granite work had commenced in south india and crafted pieces were planned to be shipped for assembling in a sense and further work in Melbourne. Nineteen artisans arrived from Chennal and little did they realise they were going to be in loadston in the temple premises for months chiselling away. 2020 for all its downside, saw the completion of this wonderful house of God. To the delight of devotees who have been holding their breath for the reopening of the Sri Vakrathunda Vinayagar Temple, that he has been set for the 25th of January 2021. The Maha Kumhabhishishkam is the grand rituatistic moving of Ganapathy from Baalaabayam into the new temple will be held on Monday 25th January 202, the auspicious time being from 9:15am to 10:30am. The preparatory rituals will start on Sunday, 17th January 2021 and will be performed upto the 25th.
